The bidders registered in India shall make payment for all tenders published on or after 01.09.2016 towards tender document cost and earnest money deposit only through online payment modes like net banking, debit/credit cards etc. available on IREPS portal. Bids received with manual/offline payment of tender cost and EMD shall be summarily rejected.	<p>Tender Document Cost : The tender document for tenders issued by Procurement Group through IREPS are free of cost.</p> <p>EMD : The bidder shall furnish at the time of bidding requisite earnest money deposit (EMD).
